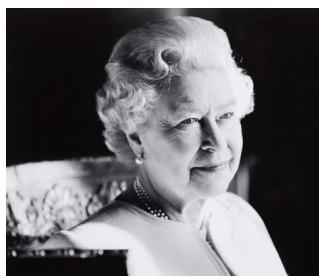

STUDENT MEDICAL PLANS

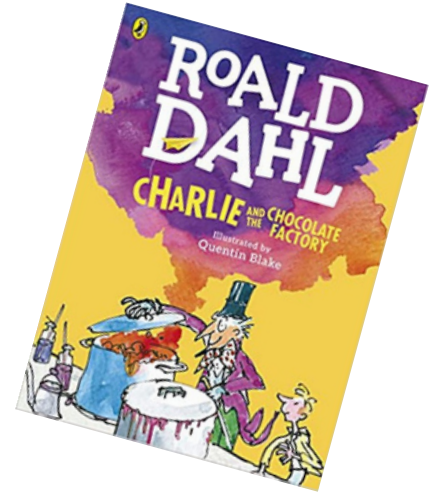

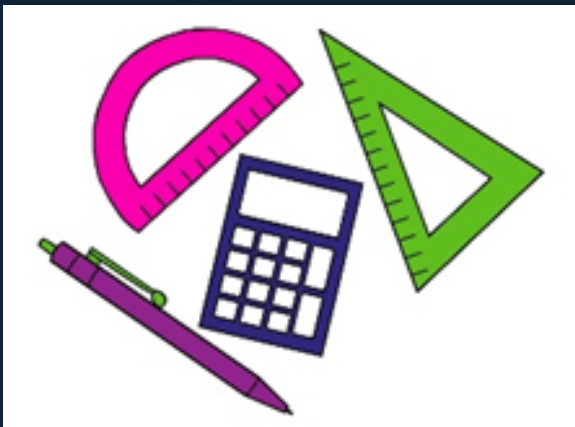
