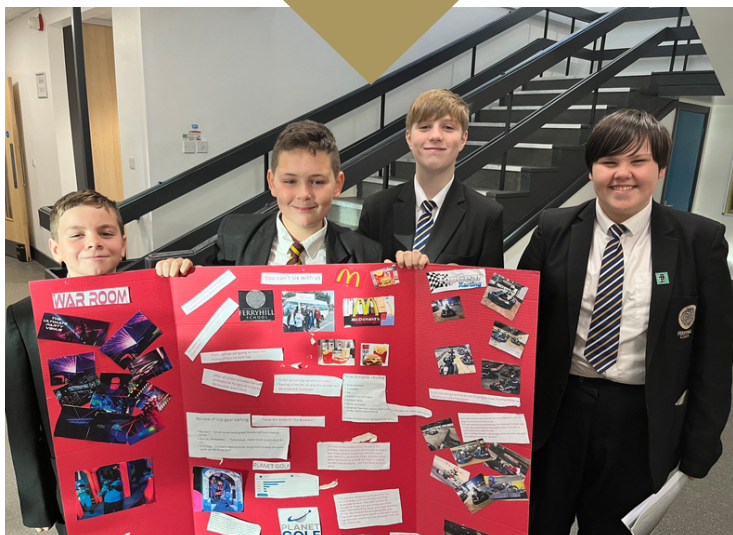
On Monday 21st 2 Key groups went to panel with their great projects.

Please note that Mrs Casemore's Sewing club will recommence on Thursday 15 December 2022.

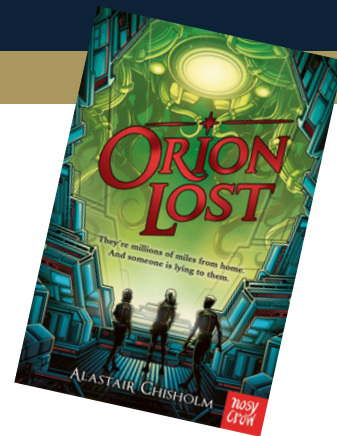


PoGo Pokemon Go Club
