School Arrival and Lateness

I would like to offer my thanks on behalf of Ferryhill School to parents and students who ensure they are punctual and arrive on time to school every day. I would also like to take the opportunity to remind students of our expectation that they arrive into the school building before 8:25am. This allows students to have a positive start to the day by arriving at lessons on time and ready to learn by 8:30am. Students who arrive after 8:30am will be marked as late and our Behaviour Policy applied as appropriate. Students who are late by more than 10 minutes on a single occasion, will receive an automatic C4 detention. Those who are late into school on more than one occasion in a half term, will also receive a C4 detention. This C4 detention will repeat for every consequent late to school in the same half term. We appreciate that on rare occasions unforeseen circumstances may lead to lateness. In these instances, it is parents' responsibility to contact school to avoid students receiving unnecessary sanctions.

YEAR 7/8 NETBALL TEAM

The year 7 and 8 netball matches are beginning shortly, students will need to stay back at school until approximately 4.30pm on match nights, depending on home or away fixtures. All students need to wear full correct PE kit. Please ensure you attend netball practice on Wednesdays after school.


